

## SEVEN CORE REQUIREMENTS OF THE FAIR DEFENSE ACT

- Prompt and accurate magistration hearings
- 2. Develop a standard of indigence and process to determine eligibility
- 3. Timely appointment of counsel
- 4. Minimum attorney qualifications
- 5. Fair, neutral, and non-discriminatory attorney selection process
- 6. Standard attorney fee schedule and payment process
- 7. State reporting

 Program goal: reduce pretrial conditions over time

 Pretrial identifies when someone's conditions should be reduced

# Bexar Co. Programs

Jail-based Competency Restoration Program

 Pretrial worked with the MAC to identify attorneys who are proactive in working with MH defendants

 Pretrial training of court-appointed attorneys on the MH process, diversion programs


